He has received multiple Dove Award nominations and his latest project "Love, Love, Love" was nominated at the 61st Annual Grammy Awards as "Best Roots Gospel Album of the Year." This nomination follows on the heels of his widely acclaimed project "Gordon Mote Sings Hymns and Songs of Inspiration" which was nominated at The 59th Annual Grammy Awards, in the same category. He has garnered multiple awards and nominations in Christian music including "Musician of The Year," "Song of the Year," "Producer of the Year", and "Album of The Year."

Gordon began playing piano at the age of 3 and toured with his family. His undeniable talent has made him an award-winning Nashville sessions player in demand for such notable artists as Alan Jackson, George Strait, Blake Shelton, Brad Paisley, Darius Rucker and Josh Turner to name a few. The list goes on with such names as Pop artists, Lionel Ritchie, Kid Rock, Carrie Underwood and every notable Gospel artist. Gordon traveled over six years singing and playing for the popular Gaither Homecoming concerts and multiple Grammy Award winning Gaither Vocal Band. He currently performs approximately 130 solo concerts per year.

The vocalist, producer and keyboardist extraordinaire has been blind since birth, but his words and music reach beyond the ears to the heart. More than his incredible talent, Mote's fans appreciate his ability to communicate the love of Christ to a world in need of hope.
